How much power should each state hold compared to our national government? Before the Civil War there was the Nullification Crisis of 1832 involving South Carolina's nullification of laws, a battle in Congress, and the failing southern economy, culminating in a threat to secede from the Union. How did Andrew Jackson deal with this issue of states' rights? In this lesson students will explore these questions and more as we talk about the growing tensions between the states leading to the Nullification Crisis of 1832.
