Hands-on-History

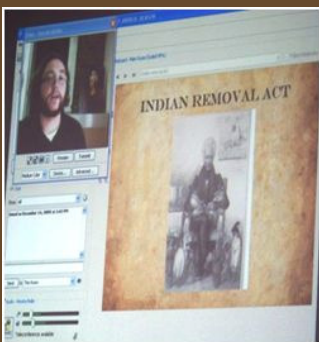
\$7/student (Title I rate: \$5/student)
